- Empower deaf, hard of hearing, and hearing individuals, regardless of their health literacy, to access reliable health information

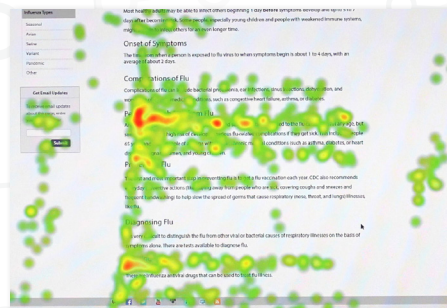
What is involved in this study?
